Ask ChatGPT or your chosen LLM for attribution of what it has produced i.e. “Can you provide a reference for that please?” You can also check this reference actually exists. If you find a reference that does not exist, try “This reference doesn’t exist. Please give me a real reference”.

Now with your working group write your own list of 6 characteristics of a purposeful and responsible use of AI in libraries – use all of your thinking above to do this. You can also rank your list of items and compare them to your answers for 1B.
